Examples

Example #1

We asked: Tell us some of the things you really like about your school or things that could make it even better.

You said: “I feel like we don’t have enough school spirit.”

We say: The staff and school administration appreciate your feedback, and plan to create a Student-Staff Committee to see what activities students are most interested in. Please listen to daily announcements or check the school’s social media accounts for further details on how to join and/or contribute!



Example #2



We asked: Students to respond to questions about their sense of belonging at school.

You said: More than 25% of you said you don't feel like you belong.

We say: We plan to hold an intramural event where each homeroom will work together to become the school homeroom champion. More details will be announced in your next homeroom.

Example #3

We asked: We asked about your feelings of safety at school.

You said: Survey results indicated students do not feel safe in the school washrooms.

We say: We hear your concerns and are working to address them. We plan to hold a student focus group to better understand safety issues in our school washrooms. Remember, you can always talk to or email an adult at the school to discuss your concerns.
